EC §48205	Excused absences (amended): A copy of Section 48205 is required to be provided to parents; updated 1/1/2022.
<u>STATUTES</u>	
EC §35292.6	Menstrual products (amended): Requires a school maintaining any combination of classes from grade 6 to 12 to stock the school's restrooms at all times with an adequate supply of free menstrual products (pads and tampons), in all women's restrooms and all-gender restrooms, and in at least one men's restroom, and to post a notice that includes the text of this section in every restroom, including the email address and telephone number, for a designated individual responsible for maintaining the requisite supply of menstrual products.
EC §37222.21	September 11 th Remembrance (new): Encourages schools to observe a moment of silence at an appropriate time while school is in session when September 11 th Remembrance Day falls on a school day.
EC §48851	Homeless questionnaire (new): Requires LEAs to administer, in the primary language of parent on unaccompanied youth, a housing questionnaire, as specified, for purposes of identifying homeless children and youths and unaccompanied youths.
EC §48852.6	Internet posting of homeless information (new): Requires district to post on its internet website a list of homeless liaisons and their contact information and information regarding the educational rights and resources available to persons experiencing homelessness.
EC §51225.7	Financial aid applications (amended): Requires the Board of an LEA to confirm a pupil completes and submits a FAFSA or, if exempt from paying nonresident tuition, completes and submits the Student Aid Commission under CA Dream Act.

FM §6323.5 Domestic violence (new): Authorizes a court to include in an

records and information pertaining to the education or

employment of a minor child of the parties.
